3.0 Update from RNLD Strategic Development Project Group

Owen referenced three papers which has been prepared and circulated to the group members prior to the meeting in relation to:

A . Population health needs of people with learning disabilities

Obesity/Dementia was cited as a health need.

Roisin suggested going to informatics within the HSC organisations however it was acknowledged that if a person had a Learning Disability that may not necessarily be recorded. Barbara Tate link with the Health Facilitators group and feedback at the next meeting.

There is debate regarding the terminology Learning Disabilities vs intellectual disability – Owen suggested this should be raised with the RNLD Strategic Project Group in the first instance.

Michelle Curran highlighted we must be mindful of the views of service users and carers and RNLDs

B. RNLD Regional Workforce Scoping

The paper is based on scoping exercise across the five HSC Trusts. Recognised that there is a significant number of RNLDs working outside HSC. The independent sector is having its own Delivering Care strand and that information will be captured in that process.

C. Learning and Development Framework - Strategic RNLD Workforce Engagement Event. Feedback has been sent back by the Consultant Nurses to Owen and Cathy. Owen emphasised that in going forward the role of the RNLD needs to be aligned to the population health needs of people with learning disabilities based on the best available evidence e.g. NICE Guidance – and a move away from creating parallel services for people with learning disabilities and development of a regionally agreed career pathway
