FB presented the collated data and discussion took place on core duties identified from the Steering Group meeting along with the information returned from the BHSCT and WHSCT. Agreement was provided by the Group on a number of outstanding core duties and the scoping tool was updated accordingly. A small number of core duties (see below) still remain for continued discussion and will be cross checked with UK counterparts before being bought back to the Steering Group for further discussion and agreement.
