Discussion was held around the possibility for those who already had a Specialist Practice Qualification eg District Nursing, could they use APEL for the core modules if they wanted to gain a Specialist Practice Qualification (SPQ) in Diabetes Nursing. Cuts to the Education Commissioning Group's (ECG) budget was also impacting in on this Project as Non-Medical Prescribing places were being cut. Sharon McRoberts and Annetta Quigley agreed to advise the next ECG meeting of the outcomes of this Project in relation to the need for SPQs and Non-Medical Prescribing as a priority.
