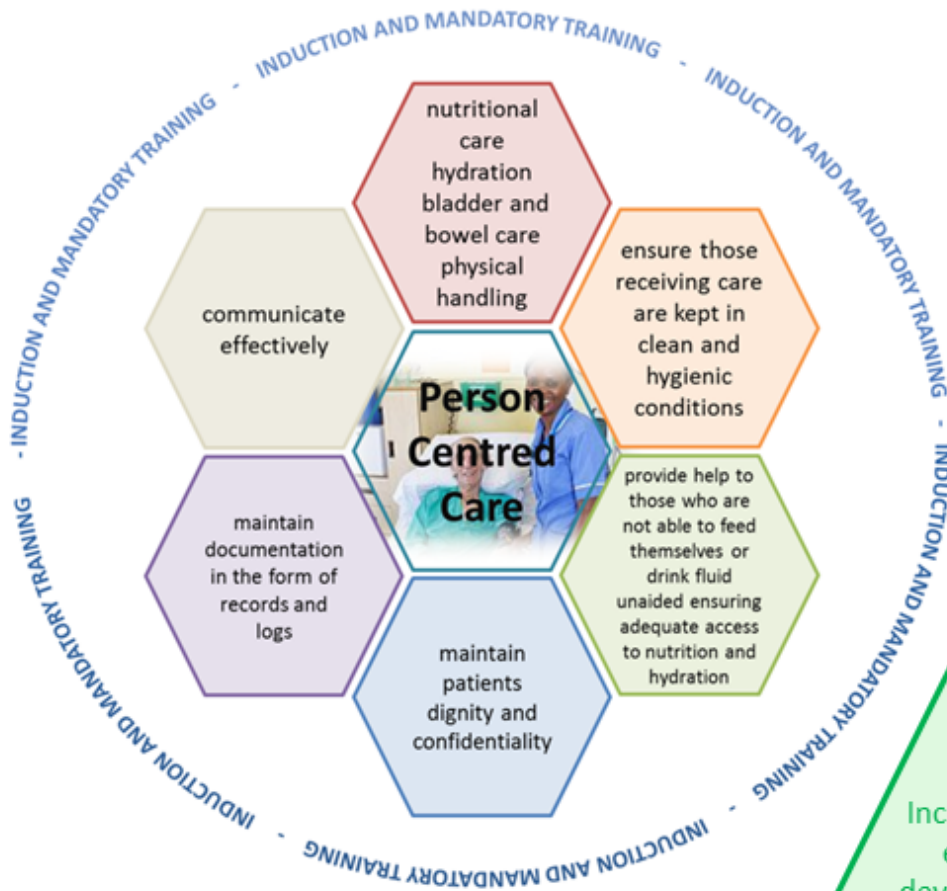


Nursing Assistant Emergency Care Band 3
